



## **Call for Nominations - 2026 NAME Board of Directors**

NAME is currently seeking nominations for the following Board of Directors (“Board”) positions:

**Officers:**     **President-Elect**  
                  **Secretary (*appointed*)**

**Regional & At Large Representatives:**

**Region 1: State Medicaid Agency**  
**Region 2: Local Education Agency**  
**Region 3: State Education Agency**  
**At Large: State Medicaid Agency**

All nominees must be NAME voting members in good standing or eligible to be voting members and are currently employed in a field directly involved or immediately related to school-based Medicaid. Associate members are not eligible to hold board positions. Elected Board Officers and Representatives serve terms as specified in the NAME Bylaws. The Board may appoint a qualified nominee to fill the term of any Board vacancy that arises before an election can be held for that Board position.

Please consider nominating individuals who meet the qualifications for these important offices to support NAME. You may nominate yourself. The election will be held electronically from Monday May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026 – Friday May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2026. The results of the election will be announced within two (2) weeks of the final election. All newly elected NAME Board members will serve a three (3) year term, except for appointed positions of secretary and treasurer who each serve a two (2) year term. Elected board members and appointed officers will attend the annual Long Range Planning Meeting at the start of the annual conference for mentorship, and the term will officially begin at the conclusion of the annual NAME Conference in September 2026 in Chicago, IL.
